**a. Requests for Prevention Exposure:**

- Committee is requesting pre-conference learning community.
- Produce prevention showcase with more room for tabling (minimize number to speak), one keynote on PV (PED talk on paper) or PV panel, media from young people showcased during conference.
- Carl: supports the idea of this.
- Jeff: panel should be submitted as a proposal before the 18<sup>th</sup>,

- Susan: Wants to discuss and know how do we create a comprehensive prevention program for PG.
- Was proposed to co-chairs, something similar to MADD.
- Julie: intermediate/advanced level discussion for this panel – it needs to fit into other categories, broader than ATOD.
- Mike: agree we should integrate other areas.
- Wuelfing: for a keynote: add someone who can include how everyone in the continuum of care has a role in prevention – to get larger buy-in; he just wrote a curriculum for SAMHSA on the intersection of prevention and treatment approaches – so he could pull a few slides and provide that piece.
- Roxanne: be thoughtful about pre-conference meeting that it would bump up against other pre-conference workshops that are paid for – it creates competition.
- Jeff: last couple of years they have done a non CEU colloquium that has gone well.
- Carl: concerns about supporting without a structured agenda/topic.
- Roxanne: proposes for a breakfast meeting.
- Jim will add it to the list.

- Amanda P: data project on how to find data for targeted PV efforts.
